#### 1 Objective

The objective of these Regulations is to amend the Oaths and Affirmations (Affidavits, Statutory Declarations and Certifications) Regulations 2018 to prescribe a class of authorised affidavit takers.

#### 2 Authorising provision

These Regulations are made under section 52 of the **Oaths and Affirmations Act 2018**.

#### **3** Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 1 March 2019.

#### 4 Prescribed authorised affidavit takers

In regulation 5(2) of the Oaths and Affirmations (Affidavits, Statutory Declarations and Certifications) Regulations  $2018^1$ —

- (a) in paragraph (d), for "described." substitute "described;";
- (b) after paragraph (d) insert—
  - "(e) persons employed under Part 3 of the **Public Administration Act 2004** with a classification level of 2 or 3, however described, in a court or tribunal when acting in the course of their duties in relation to that court or tribunal.".
