1 Objective

The objective of these Regulations is to amend the Oaths and Affirmations (Affidavits, Statutory Declarations and Certifications) Regulations 2018 to prescribe a class of authorised affidavit takers.

2 Authorising provision

These Regulations are made under section 52 of the **Oaths and Affirmations Act 2018**.

3 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 1 March 2019.

4 Prescribed authorised affidavit takers

In regulation 5(2) of the Oaths and Affirmations
(Affidavits, Statutory Declarations and
Certifications) Regulations 2018¹—

(a) in paragraph (d), for "described." **substitute**
"described;"

(b) after paragraph (d) **insert**—

"(e) persons employed under Part 3 of the
Public Administration Act 2004 with
a classification level of 2 or 3, however
described, in a court or tribunal when
acting in the course of their duties in
relation to that court or tribunal."
