1 Objective

The objective of these Regulations is to provide transitional arrangements for a statutory declaration made on or after 1 March 2019 but before 1 January 2020, which would have been validly made under the **Evidence (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1958** had it been made before 1 March 2019.

2 Authorising provision

These Regulations are made under section 59 of the **Oaths and Affirmations Act 2018**.

3 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 1 March 2019.

4 Definitions

In these Regulations—

the Act means the **Oaths and Affirmations** Act 2018;

transitional period means the period beginning on 1 March 2019 and ending on 31 December 2019.

5 Statutory declarations—transitional arrangements

- A statutory declaration made during the transitional period is taken to have been a validly made statutory declaration under the Act if it is made in compliance with Division 2 of Part IV of the Evidence (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1958 (as in force immediately before its repeal) whether or not the statutory declaration is in the form prescribed under section 30(1) of the Act.
- (2) For the purposes of subregulation (1), a statutory declaration made during the transitional period is a validly made statutory declaration under the Act if it is declared before—
 - (a) a person who was authorised to witness the signing of a statutory declaration under section 107A(1) of the Evidence (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1958 as in force immediately before the repeal of that section; or
 - (b) a statutory declaration witness.

6 Expiry

These Regulations expire on 1 January 2020.
